248. v. John Munger (John, Samuel, Joseph, Samuel, Nicholas)

1800 - John and family lived in Fishkill, Dutchess, New York in the next dwelling to brother James: 2 M under 10; 1 M 16-25; 2 F under 10; 1 F 26-44 = 6 total. The 2 males under 10 and 2 females under 10 is probably a mistake by the census taker. 1810 - John was the only Munger living in Fishkill, Dutchess, NY; 5M under 10 (Abram, Isaac S., Jacob, Benjamin, Samuel); 1M 26-45 John; 1F 10-15 Jane; 1 F 26-44 Margaret = 8 in household.
